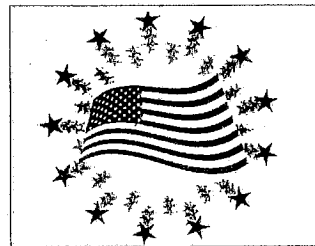

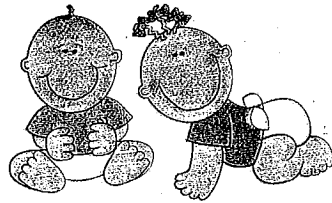


CONGRATULATIONS
